Did you know that you can rent the Community Club facilities, including the Main Hall, the Dining Room, the Kitchens, the Bill Wood Room, the concession, and the field, not only for public events but also for your group or for your own personal celebrations?

Facilities

Main Hall: Great for weddings, family reunions, and big meetings. Capacity 225.

The *dining room* and *kitchen* can be added to support your Main Hall event or rented separately. Capacity 80.

Bill Wood Room: Ideal for smaller gatherings. Capacity 75. Limited kitchen facilities are available. The Bill Wood Room is on the lower floor.

Outside Field Area: A ball field along with viewing stands, picnic tables, and a children's playground.

Concession Booth: Give your ball tournament the "ball game feel" by offering hot dogs and burgers.

About the Hall

The member owned and operated Union Bay Community Club and Recreation Association has provided Union Bay a social hub for over seventy years. The community hall and its grounds are used for public and personal gatherings, community events, community activities, and group meetings. The club's Boat Ramp Committee manages the Union Bay Boat Launch across the highway from the landmark Union Bay Post Office and mows the Union Bay Frontage Road boulevard.

Each year the club hosts a range of events including the Spring, Fall, and Christmas Craft Fairs; the March Flea Market; the Annual Fall Supper; the Annual Mother's Day Breakfast; and the Family Fun Day celebration (see *Events* for details). Ongoing activities ranging from aerobics to crib are available (see *Activities*).

The community hall is available to everyone, not only for community events and special interest gatherings, but also for your own personal celebrations (see *Rentals*).

This is your Community Club. Membership fees, rental charges, activity fees, and events income, along with your volunteered time keeps the Community Club viable year after year.
