

About the Hall

The member owned and operated Union Bay Community Club and Recreation Association has provided Union Bay a social hub for over seventy years. The community hall and its grounds are used for public and personal gatherings, community events, community activities and group meetings. The club's Boat Ramp Committee manages the Union Bay Boat Launch across the highway from the landmark Union Bay Post Office and mows the Union Bay Frontage Road boulevard.

Each year the club hosts a range of events which include the Spring, Fall and Christmas Craft Fairs, the March Flea Market, the Annual Fall Supper, the Annual Mother's Day Breakfast and the Family Fun Day (Bay Day) celebration (see *Events* for details). Ongoing activities ranging from aerobics to cards are available (see *Activities*).

The community hall is available to everyone, not only for your community events and special interest gatherings, but for your own personal celebrations. (see *Rentals*).
